




### The Value of Screen Tourism

In 2016, inbound tourists spent an estimated £597.7 million in film-related screen tourism in the UK. This spending generated 13,440 FTEs of total employment (i.e. including direct, indirect and induced impacts) and £628.3 million in total GVA. This economic activity yielded an estimated £194.9 million in tax revenue.





#### Filming Locations From the Series

Based on the bestselling books by Julia Quinn and produced by Shonda Rhimes (of Grey's Anatomy and Scandal), the period drama Bridgerton, set in England in the early 1800s, follows the Bridgerton family and their high society lives and romances.

From the cobbled and picturesque Abbey Green, which stood in for a market square in the series, to The Holburne Museum, which was Lady Danbury's grand mansion, and to Bath Street, the perfect Regency thoroughfare, various city locations in Bath were used extensively in the filming of Bridgerton.

We've earmarked them and provided information about each spot, which means planning a trip to see where Bath features on screen couldn't be easier...

#### Take a 360° Tour of the on-Screen Spots


Visit Bath and walk in the footsteps of Daphne Bridgerton and the Duke of Hastings, albeit virtually – from the comfort of your own sofa – with our Google Earth tour.

We've put together a walk-through of nine different city locations that were used when filming the series, which, thanks to Google Street View, lets you get a feel of the Georgian grandeur and golden Bath stone which attracted the producers to shoot Bridgerton in Bath.


From zooming in on Lady Danbury's mansion, at the head of the widest thoroughfare in the city, to checking out the exterior of the Featherington family's abode, by showing where all the spots are located, the tour gives you a visual idea of how they relate to one another in terms of distance, in a city which is compact and very walkable.

Zoom out to see all the location pins on the map, and then swoop in to street level, scoping out exact spots from the series!


